A member of the Royal Photographic Society I was shortlisted in 2021 for the Royal Photographic Society International Photography Exhibition (IPE163) and was awarded two honorable mentions in 2022 for the 18th Julia Margaret Cameron Award for women photographers and the 18th Pollux awards hosted by Fotonostrum in Barcelona, and again in 2023 for 20th Julia Margaret Cameron Awards. My work has recently been featured in Art Doc and Spectaculum online magazines promoting the arts and photography across Europe and world-wide, and most recently in the August edition of Art Etcetera a publication based in Wales, devoted to Art in all its forms.

After many years working and creating historical costumes for clients including the National Trust, I now devote my time to art photography.
